
A journey of an Israeli in Palestine



Conversation with Miko Peled

Miko Peled is an author of the book "The General's Son" (2012) and a peace activist. Born into a prominent Zionist family (his grandfather was one of the signatories of the Israeli Declaration of Independence; his father was an army general), Miko Peled underwent a painful transformation from a member of the Israeli Special Forces into a staunch proponent of the "one state solution".

How is Miko Peled being received by Israelis and Palestinians? Are his ideas marginal and naïve or the only realistic way towards peace? What has caused him to reassess his views on the conflict? Is he optimistic about the future given the current political and social circumstances in the region?
